UNESCO-World Heritage City of Quedlinburg

The UNESCO-World Heritage City of Quedlinburg is the centre of half-timbered buildings in Europe. There are also several sights from the Ottonian Empire (10/11th century). This was the reason in 1994 for the UNESCO to award Quedlinburg its status as a World Heritage Site. Special highlights are the castle hill with the Collegiate Church St. Servatius including the famous cathedral treasure and the castle museum, but also the unique Lyonel-Feininger-Gallery with the largest collection of prints in Europe of this great Bauhaus-Master.
